T 1	<i>All schools will operate as normal</i>	Announcements of school closures, before the start of the school day, will be made on the radio and television from 6.00 am onwards.
L 3	<i>All primary and secondary schools will operate as normal, unless advised otherwise.</i>	
<p>NW 西北 SE 東南 SW 西南 NE 東北</p>	<i>All schools will close.</i>	<p>In the event of a Typhoon number 8, or a Red/Black rainstorm warning, while the children are at school:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE SCHOOL AS OUR LINES GET BLOCKED. Check your emails and text messages regularly for up to the minute information. Parents of children who do not use the school bus should arrange to collect their child, as soon as it is safe to do so. If a Typhoon number 8 or a Red/Black rainstorm warning is already in operation, while the children are at school, the school buses will not leave school. Children MUST be collected from school by a parent or designated adult, as soon as it is safe to do so.

<p>Red 紅</p> <p>Black 黑</p>	<p><i>(i) Before start of school - All schools will close for the whole day.</i></p> <p><i>(ii) After students have set off for school, but before the commencement of school - If students arrive at school they will be supervised until it is safe for them to be collected.</i></p> <p><i>(iii) When classes are in session - Schools continue until the end of normal school hours and students are retained until conditions are safe for them to return home.</i></p>
